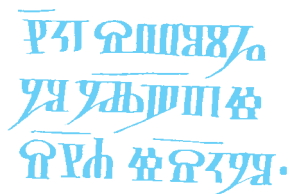

Inscriptions written in the old Slavic language were discovered in Preslavl, the former capital of Bulgaria – the inscriptions were made on the walls and ceramic plates of the Church of Simeon (893–927). The inscriptions included only three lines: the upper one was made in

Glagolitic alphabet while the lower two were written in Cyrillic. The date – the year 893 – is clearly noted in one place. Ostromir's New Testament is the ancient exactly dated text. Two scribes rewrote it on assignment of Novgorod ruler Ostromir in 1056–1057.

The oldest dateless manuscript was written in the Glagolitic alphabet and dates back to the tenth century. The available ancient texts allow to analyze in detail each letter of Cyrillic and Glagolitic alphabets and to trace the evolution of the kindred Slavic alphabets.
